

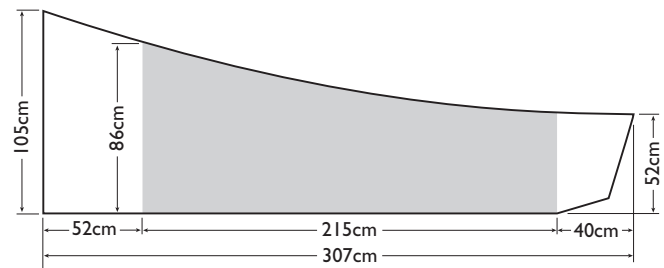
Torside 1P single-wall tent



This is my lightest 1 person shelter and at 654g is perfect for lightweight travel. As with all my tents it is ideal for use with trekking poles, although DAC poles can be purchased separately.

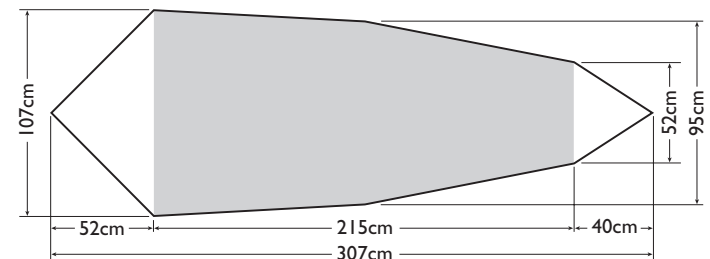
Features

- Very low weight
- Stable in strong winds
- Alternative trekking pole support
- Fast set up in 3 minutes
- Front and rear doors open up to allow maximum venting (can be kept open in the rain)
- Small porch area
- Reinforced tie-outs and apex pole supports
- Side wall tie-outs

- Weight (inc. guylines, shock cords and tensioners)
Flysheets/groundsheet: 654g
- Ripstop Flysheet
40 Den, 55g/m²
x2 Silicon coated both sides
Hydrostatic Head: 3,500mm
- Ripstop Groundsheet
40 Den, 70g/m²
TPU coated
Hydrostatic Head: 10,000mm
- Mosquito netting
155 mesh cm²
Polyamid 25g/m²
- Guylines: 2mm Dyneema cord with Clamcleats
- YKK zips



WARNING!
